

## **Touristic information Paris**

**LE LOUVRE MUSEUM:** The Louvre or Louvre Museum is one of the world's largest museums and a historic monument. Nearly 35,000 objects from prehistory to the 21st century are exhibited over an area of 60,600 square meters (652,300 square feet). With more than 8 million visitors each year, the Louvre is the world's most visited museum

**EIFFEL TOWER:** The Eiffel Tower is an iron lattice tower located on the Champ de Mars in Paris. It was named after the engineer Gustave Eiffel, whose company designed and built the tower. Erected in 1889 as the entrance arch to the 1889 World's Fair, it has become both a global cultural icon of France and one of the most recognizable structures in the world. The tower is the tallest structure in Paris.

**CHATEAU DE VERSAILLES:** The Palace of Versailles is a royal château in Versailles in the Île-de-France region of France. Court of Versailles was the center of political power in France from 1682, when Louis XIV moved from Paris, until the royal family was forced to return to the capital in October 1789 after the beginning of the French Revolution. Versailles is therefore famous not only as a building, but as a symbol of the system of absolute monarchy of the Ancient Régime. In order to get the most of your day in Versailles, we advise you to arrive when the Estate opens. Your visit must be made on the date indicated on the ticket.

**CHAMPS ELYSEES AND ARC DE TRIOMPHE:** Possibly the most famous road in the world, Champs Elysées is a picturesque tree lined avenue that runs from the Arc de Triomphe towards the Louvre. It is an incredibly romantic place and a real symbol of Paris and France. The Arc de Triomphe is a stunning war monument that was commissioned by Napoleon in 1806 to honor his great victories.

CATACOMBS OF PARIS: Through an in-depth path, the visitors discover the area thoroughly, like Décure's sculptures, the quarries footbath, the Sacellum Crypt, the sepulchral lamp and Gilbert's tomb. The Catacombs of Paris are underground ossuaries in Paris, France which hold the remains of over six million people in a small part of the ancient Mines of Paris tunnel network. Located south of the former city gate "Barrière d'Enfer" (Gate of Hell) beneath Rue de la Tombe-Issoire, the ossuary was founded when city officials were faced with two simultaneous problems: a series of cave-ins starting in 1774 and overflowing cemeteries, particularly Saint Innocents. Booking must be made 8 weeks in advance.



#### **Touristic information Nice**

**CASTLE HILL:** The city's original site, the Castle Hill once boasted a reputedly impregnable citadel that was entirely dismantled by the soldiers of the French King Louis XIV in 1706. Truly a maze of greenery that has become popular for its cool undergrowth and surprising waterfall, this wonderful place for strolling offers a wonderful viewpoint over Baie des Anges, Old Nice and the Port (orientation table). The lighting at night is spectacular.

**PROMENADE DES ANGLAIS:** Nice's Promenade des Anglais is part of the heart of this seaside French city. It is lined with cafes situated directly on the beach, and it's a bustling area active with cyclists, runners, walkers and rollerbladers.

**PRINCE'S PALACE OF MONACO:** The Prince's Palace is the private residence of the ruling Prince but the State Apartments along with the Napoleon Museum are open for public visits part of the year. There is a collection of more than a thousand objects and documents relating to the First Empire: objects belonging to the Emperor Napoleon 1, garments of the King of Rome, and religious souvenirs from Saint Helena.

**MONACO VILLE:** Monaco-Ville is the old town of Monaco and one of its administrative divisions. It is located on a rocky headland that extends into the Mediterranean Sea. Monaco-Ville is one of the four traditional quarters of Monaco, the others being La Condamine, Monte Carlo, and Fontvieille.

**LA COTE D'AZUR (FRENCH RIVIERA):** The Côte d'Azur, often known in English as the French Riviera, is the Mediterranean coastline of the southeast corner of France, also including the sovereign state of Monaco. There is no official boundary, but it is usually considered to extend from the Italian border in the east to Saint-Tropez, Hyères, Toulon, or Cassis in the West.

**RUE D'ANTIBE:** The main shopping street in Cannes France is called the Rue d'Antibes. Many expensive shops that cater to the rich and famous can be found along this famous street. All sorts of designer clothing, furniture and jewellery can be found on Rue d'Antibes.

OCEANOGRAPHIC MUSEUM OF MONACO: Aquariums, exhibitions, games and relaxation...the Oceanographic Museum of Monaco lets you dive into the marine world. From aquariums to its shark lagoon, passing through the Turtle Island located on the panoramic terrace, it offers a unique opportunity to know, love and protect the oceans. A crossroads between Art and Science, this Temple of the Sea is home to over 6,000 specimens and priceless collections of Natural History. Come and visit, with our exhibitions and events, you too can experience the depths of the oceans.




# How to book and payment conditions:

- 1. Contact us with any questions, concerns, or changes to the itinerary.
- 2. Share and discuss the itinerary proposal with your group and set a date to get commitments for the tour. Make sure to share the General Conditions Document Form (document sent in the same email as this proposal) with the group as well so all participants understand the terms and conditions.
- 3. Set a date to collect deposits to commit to the tour. We require a non-refundable US\$ 200.00 deposit per person to book the tour see below for more information about payments.
- 4. Once you have deposits and are ready to book the tour, fill out the Booking Form (document sent in the same e-mail as this proposal) and send it back to us along with the group's deposit.
- 5. Check our "<u>Travel Prep Guide"</u> on our website for more information on international travel and steps to prepare your group for the tour.

#### Additional information about payments:

Your group can make (bi) monthly payment installments to pay for the tour. The payment installments will be discussed between Premier International Tours and the group leader to ensure that the installments will work for all participants and overseas partners involved in the tour.

These installments can be made by credit card or by check. If any participant decides to pay by credit card we will make a customized credit card authorization form for your group which would then need to be filled out by your group participants and sent back to us. We will keep this form on file for each installment. If the participant decides that he/she would like to pay by check the check will need to be sent in the mail a week before the installment is due to ensure that the payment is made on time.
